It is the dawn of yet a new day, the 30th of December in the year of Our Lord Jesus Christ 2005. Blessed above all the Heavens and the Earth is the name of the Lord. Please read this in it's entirety as I will be adding throughout until it's completion.

Once again man through sin has proved to be his own worst enemy.

I will begin with just a brief recap of “Son of Perdition” pt 1. If you have not done so go back and read it in it's entirety.

Before we begin, I the Phoenix, Jeffrey Jackson a true Servant, Apostle and Special Messenger to Our Lord Jesus Christ, welcome you to the pages of Phoenix Seven. Throughout it's pages I have spoke of the road or path that I walk as the modern day prodigal son returned. “The Road Less Traveled”. The path I walk in service to Our Lord each and every day.

I would not only at this time wish to make a clarification on this “Road Less Traveled”, but add perhaps just a bit of insight that will help you for the remainder of this message, given to me by Our Lord.

The road I walk is the one least traveled. And not to be confused with the road that many walk today within the apostate Church, nor the one that Scott Peck speaks of.

Now in opening, I would like to begin with a quote from the book by Scott Peck, author of “The Road Less Traveled”, here again a vastly different road that I walk each day. Dr Peck’s books have sold upward into the millions, and many have embraced them as truth, as I am sure many of you are familiar with his works: Reflect upon this as we begin our journey through the truth of the word of God, the scriptures.

The quotation is from Mr. Peck’s book, “The Road Less Traveled”, 1978, Touchstone Books, pages 269 and 270:

(Begin excerpt)

*“If we postulate that our capacity to love, this urge to grow and evolve, is somehow “breathed into” us by God, then we must ask to what end. Why does God want us to grow? What are we growing toward? Where is the end point the goal of evolution? What is it that God wants of us? It is not my intention here to become involved in theological niceties, and I hope the scholarly will forgive me if I cut through all the ifs, ands, and buts of proper speculative theology. For no matter how much we may like to pussyfoot around it, all of us who postulate a loving God and really think about it eventually come to a single terrifying idea: God wants us to become Himself (or Herself or Itself). **We are growing toward Godhood. God is the goal of evolution. It is God who is the source of the evolutionary force and God who is the destination. That is what we mean when we say that He is the Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the End”.***

Man, has exalted himself to “God”.

Judas denied Christ and sold Him for 30 pieces of silver. What of the man or woman that exalt themselves to God hood?

Feel like puking yet? You should. This only scratches the surface. Add in much of the “New Age” religion, that embraces this concept, (and that flows throughout society and the “God of their own understanding”,) coupled with the dead and lukewarm apostate Church, that embraces denominational division, and “Doctrine’s of Men” by which many are deceived: This is Your Man of Sin, your Son of Perdition.

### **IDOLATRY**

In the New Testament period the term idolatry began to be used as an intellectual concept. Idolatry became not the actual bowing down before a statue but the replacement of God in the mind of the worshiper. <Colossians 3:5> points in this direction: "Put to death... covetousness, which is idolatry." (See also <Eph. 5:5.>) At this point the modern believer must understand the vicious nature of idolatry. While we may not make or bow down to a statue, we must be constantly on guard that we let nothing come between us and God. As soon as anything does, that thing is an idol.

In addition to material objects such as houses, land, and cars, idols can be people, popular heroes, or those whom we love. Objects of worship can even include things like fame, reputation, hobbies, pride,

and deeds done in the name of the Lord. Idolatry is a dangerous and deceitful sin. No wonder prophets preached against it so often and so strongly.

Any man or woman that denies any part of the Word of God exalts himself above that Word. He or she, exalts themselves as God.

The Creation...above the Creator.

And know this: The spirit of the Anti-Christ is those that do not follow Jesus Christ. Who then can say I am of Jesus Christ, and not follow Him? Such is to Deny Christ. Just as if you had denied Him coming in the flesh. The same as have denied Him as "Lord". This is Anti-Christ.

I know more than above you all what the Church is (The Called Out Ones) and what it is not. And a fallen away Church which was foretold by scripture is not a Church at all. Come to know this very quickly.

Man through the denial of God's Word, which is Jesus Christ, has placed himself above that Word, above God. Well let's say he bases his salvation on what he thinks or "believes" to be. God is just.

Many of you have interpreted this as the “Rapture” of the Church, and some the removal of the Holy Spirit of God. The restraining force.

Know this: If the Holy Spirit were removed completely, the power of conviction would be lost during the Great Tribulation. So that force, His Spirit must still be present. The restraining force is the Holy Spirit through the Church. The light and salt of the earth.

As Apostasy occurs, that restraining force becomes weaker and weaker, for the Spirit of God cannot live in the “heart of sin” and deception of man. An apostate lukewarm church. Whose heart is far from where it should be, that has left it’s first love. What many have failed to see is the Apostasy. That comes first. And millions of you are “smack dab in the middle of it”. Save for some...a few here and there, but mainly those in the non-denominational evangelical camp. Remember those of you that embrace traditions and doctrines of men above God; to deny the Word is to deny Christ.

Many have been deceived by the “Left Behind” Series of books and films. They are the farthest from the word of God and from the truth. A deception of Satan. God has had me address, the scripture from Matthew 24 on “The Days of Noah”, and on the “taking”, what many

perceive to be the taking up of the saints in “the catching up of the Rapture”. This is not so. This beloved is the taking in judgment of an apostate church. “Once Saved Always Saved” - Security of the Believer” Be careful what you believe.

Know this.. This is not “Perseverance of the Saints”. And to those of you by the millions that are lost in the world, you have not even started to overcome it.

Apostasy. The falling away first. This is the taking of the Church that for this scripture, many or some of you believe to be the rapture, when in reality it the removal of the Spirit through apostasy. Many of you attempt to meld or place this with the “twinkle:

**<sup>51</sup>Behold, I shew you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed, <sup>52</sup>In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed. - 1 Corinthians 15:31-32**

You look for the twinkle, when in reality you should be praying to find yourself worthy to escape...judgment. You look for the twinkle with your heads in the clouds, and fail to work out your salvation with fear and trembling. To remove the apostasy... repent... Dry Bones Hear The Word of the Lord!

Now a brief excerpt from Barnes Notes:

<sup>7</sup>Verse 7. *For the mystery of iniquity.* On the meaning of the word *mystery*, #Rom 11:25|. Comp. #1Cor 2:7, Eph 1:9|; #Eph 3:3, Col 1:26|. It means properly that which is *hidden* or *concealed*; not necessarily that which is *unintelligible*. The "mystery of iniquity," seems here to refer to some hidden or concealed depravity-some form of sin which was working secretly and silently: and which had not yet developed itself. Any secret sources of iniquity in the church-- anything that tended to corrupt its doctrines, and to destroy the simplicity of the faith of the gospel, (Once Saved Always Saved vs those that overcome will be saved) would correspond with the meaning of the word. Doddridge correctly supposes that this may refer to the pride and ambition of some ministers, the factious temper

of some Christians, the imposing of unauthorized severities, the worship of angels, etc.

I have just now scanned the various commentaries... and let's say JFB has it right this time:

**that he might be** — *Greek*, “in order that”: ye know that which keeps him back, in God's purposes, from being sooner manifested, “*in order that he may be revealed in his own time*” (that is, the time appointed by God to him as his proper time for being manifested), not sooner (compare Dan 11:35). The removal of the withholding power will be when the civil polity, derived from the Roman empire, which is to be, in its last form, divided into ten kingdoms (Rev 17:3, Rev 17:11-13), shall, with its leading representative head for the time being (“he who now letteth,” *Greek*, “withholdeth,” as in 2Th 2:6), yield to the prevalent godless “lawlessness” with “the lawless one” as its embodiment. *The elect Church* and *the Spirit* cannot well be, as Deuteronomy Burgh suggests, the *withholding* power meant; for both shall never be *wholly* “taken out of the way” (Mat 28:20). However, the testimony of the elect Church, and the Spirit in her, are the great hindrance to the rise of the apostasy; and it is possible that, though the Lord shall have a faithful few even then, yet the full energy of the Spirit in the visible Church, counteracting the energy or “working” of “the mystery of lawlessness” by the testimony of the elect, shall have been so far “taken out of the way,” or set aside, as to admit the manifestation of “the lawless one”; and so Deuteronomy Burgh's view may be right (Luk 18:8; Rev 11:3-12). This was a power of which the Thessalonians might easily “know” through Paul's instruction.

I know more than above you all what the Church is (The Called Out Ones) and what it is not. And a fallen away Church which was foretold by scripture is not a Church at all. Come to know this very quickly.

**Yet do not be deceived. There is an Anti-Christ, “The Little Horn” on the beast of Daniel that many of you are looking for. His time**

**is not yet. But know this, He is here among us, now. “The Little Snake”.**

In the meantime beloved, concentrate on the task set before you. The task at hand. Follow Jesus Christ. Focus on Him.

And know this beloved: There are no “Halfway Christians”. Such is “Lukewarm”.

**<sup>59</sup>And he said unto another, Follow me. But he said, Lord, suffer me first to go and bury my father. <sup>60</sup>Jesus said unto him, Let the dead bury their dead: but go thou and preach the kingdom of God. <sup>61</sup>And another also said, Lord, I will follow thee; but let me first go bid them farewell, which are at home at my house. <sup>62</sup>And Jesus said unto him, No man, having put his hand to the plough, and looking back, is fit for the kingdom of God. - The Gospel According to Luke 9:59-62**

And know this: The spirit of the Anti-Christ is those that do not follow Jesus Christ. Who then can say I am of Jesus Christ, and not follow Him? Such is to Deny Christ. Just as if you had denied Him coming in the flesh. The same as have denied Him as “Lord”. This is Anti-Christ.

Earlier, I wrote to you that quite often “Less is More”. But never in matters of Love, matters of the Heart... and such as following Jesus Christ.

It is by faith that it MIGHT BE BY GRACE.... Those that have fallen from faith are no longer under grace but under Law...those that walk in the flesh and not the Spirit are under Law and not Grace.

***This I say then, Walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfil the lust of the flesh. <sup>17</sup>For the flesh lusteth against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh: and these are contrary the one to the other: so that ye cannot do the things that ye would. <sup>18</sup>But if ye be led of the Spirit, ye are not under the law. <sup>19</sup>Now the works of***

the flesh are manifest, which are *these* ; Adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lasciviousness, <sup>20</sup>Idolatry, witchcraft, hatred, variance, emulations, wrath, strife, seditions, heresies, <sup>21</sup>Envyings, murders, drunkenness, revellings, and such like: of the which I tell you before, as I have also told *you* in time past, that they which do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God. - Galatians 5:16-21

<sup>14</sup>For if they which are of the law *be* heirs, faith is made void, and the promise made of none effect: <sup>15</sup>Because the law worketh wrath: for where no law is, *there is* no transgression.

*Worketh wrath.* Produces or causes wrath. While man is fallen, and a sinner, its tendency, so far from *justifying* him, and producing peace, is just the reverse. It condemns, denounces wrath, and produces suffering. The word *wrath* here is to be taken in the sense of punishment, #Rom 2:8|; and the meaning is, that the law of God, demanding perfect purity, and denouncing every sin, condemns the sinner, and consigns him to punishment. As the apostle had proved #Rom 1:1-3:29| that all were sinners, so it followed that if any attempted to be justified by the *law*, they would be involved only in condemnation and wrath.

*For where no law is,* etc. This is a general principle; a maxim of common justice and of common sense. Law is a rule of conduct. If no such rule is given and known, there can be no crime. Law expresses what may be done, and what may not be done. If there is no command to pursue a certain course, no injunction to forbid certain conduct, actions will be innocent. The connexion in which this declaration is made here seems to imply, that as the Jews had a multitude of clear laws, and as the Gentiles had the laws of nature, there could be no hope of escape from the charge of their violation. Since human nature was depraved, and men were prone to sin, the more just and reasonable the laws, the less hope was there of being justified *by* the law, and the more certainty was there that the law would produce wrath and condemnation.

It is a Matter of Heart". This abomination of desolation.

**<sup>14</sup>And unto the angel of the church of the Laodiceans write; These things saith the Amen, the faithful and true witness, the beginning of the creation of God;** <sup>15</sup>I know thy works, that thou art neither cold nor hot: I would thou wert cold or hot. <sup>16</sup>So then **because thou art lukewarm, and neither cold nor hot, I will spue thee out of my mouth.** <sup>17</sup>Because thou sayest, I am rich, and increased with goods, and have need of nothing; **and knowest not that thou art wretched, and miserable, and poor, and blind, and naked:** <sup>18</sup>I counsel thee to buy of me gold tried in the fire, that thou mayest be rich; and white raiment, that thou mayest be clothed, and *that* **the shame of thy nakedness do not appear;** and **anoint thine eyes with eyesalve, that thou mayest see.** <sup>19</sup>As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten: **be zealous therefore, and repent.** - Revelation 3:14-19

It is a Matter of Heart". This abomination of desolation. "Your Caught in the Eye of the Storm". God is Just. Beware of the Eye's landfall.

When the lukewarm surface, perhaps it is best to apply heat. Just as Our Lord did with the Church of Laodicea. And know this, they do not exist anymore, they are and have been desolated...

"Perhaps it is time for Our Lord to turn up the heat once more". Know this: As with the church of Sardis and the Church of Laodicea and Ephesus, you do not have to be in the "Great Tribulation" to be desolated, and experience wrath. Know this truth. Many and most of you have forgotten and lost sight of who God really is.

**<sup>10</sup>That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth;** <sup>11</sup>And **that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.** - James 1:10-11

Amen. "So Be It".

"Come out and be ye Separate from them" , Repent. So commands the Lord. I am **forewarning you** of what is to and will come. Come out an be ye separate, before wrath befalls you. A season of repentance has been granted, a "time" of return, do not

abuse this grace as many of you have done so to His grace in days past.

**<sup>16</sup>Then let them which be in Judaea flee into the mountains:**

A metaphor.

Verse 16. *Then let them*, etc. Then Christians may know that the end is come, and should seek a place of safety. A Hebrew expression denoting to flee to a place of safety.

And now a brief glimpse of what is yet to come:

**<sup>15</sup>And the kings of the earth, and the great men, and the rich men, and the chief captains, and the mighty men, and every bondman, and every free man, hid themselves in the dens and in the rocks of the mountains; <sup>16</sup>And said to the mountains and rocks, Fall on us, and hide us from the face of him that sitteth on the throne, and from the wrath of the Lamb: <sup>17</sup>For the great day of his wrath is come; and who shall be able to stand? -**

Revelation 6:15-17

And now for a bit of commentary.

<sup>16</sup>Verse 16. *And said to the mountains and rocks, Fall on us*, etc.. This language is found substantially in #Hoss 10:8|: "And they shall say to the mountains, Cover us; and to the hills, Fall on us." It is also used by the Saviour as denoting the consternation which would occur at his coming: "Then shall they begin to say to the mountains, Fall on us; and to the hills, Cover us," #Lk 23:30|. It is language denoting consternation, and an awful fear of impending wrath. The state of mind is that where there is an apprehension that God himself is coming forth with the direct instruments of his vengeance, and where there is a desire rather to be crushed by falling rocks and hills than by the vengeance of his uplifted arm.

*From the face of him that sitteth on the throne.* The face of God-- for he seems to be coming forth with the displays of his vengeance. It is not said that God would actually come forth in a visible form, but their consternation would be as great as if he were to do this; the state of

mind indicated by this was an apprehension that it would be so.

*And from the wrath of the Lamb.* The Lamb of God; the Lord Jesus. #Rev 5:6|. There seems to be an incongruity between the words *wrath* and *Lamb*; but the word *Lamb* here is so far a proper name as to be used only to designate the Redeemer. He comes forth to execute wrath, not as a Lamb, but as the Son of God, who bore that name. It would seem from this that they who thus dreaded the impending terrors were aware of their source, or had knowledge enough to understand by whom they were to be inflicted. They would see that these were *Divine* judgments, and would apprehend that the end of the world drew near.

end of excerpt)

Not quite the God of Love only that many of you have idolized God and Jesus Christ to be. Is it?

Know the truth. God is a loving God, as He is Just.

Just are His judgments upon the earth. "The Horsemen of the Apocalypse" are the judgments of God upon the earth with the last rider the "Pale Horse" being the "little horn", the Anti-Christ. It is he who Hell and Hades follows, and a quarter of the world will fall, to his "unholy traits".

But their time is not of yet. This is just the "warmup". The beginning of the travail.

“Caught in the Dark Eye of the Storm”. Do not look forward to it’s landfall.

To those in the Church that embrace false doctrine and the lie. Know that you are not under Grace but under Law. To deny the Word is to Deny Christ. And that is the Word of God, and not the one of your fleshy understanding. “Your Doctrines of Mere Men”.

Do not be surprised, to be caught in the Dark Eye of the Storm”.

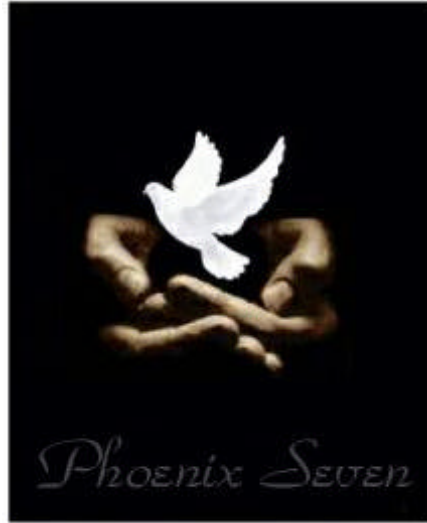
