You perhaps can add to the above analogy that you can attempt to twist it's truth, conform it, and shape it into something other than it's not, and it will spring back hitting you square in the chest as a double edged sword, cleaving you in two. It's blade offers not only instruction, comfort and consolation,.. but conviction; and for some perdition.. ..

It is truly eternal. It is alive, animated like Adam by the very Spirit and breath of God. "Breathed In". It is that very breath. A living Word.

It is the Logos. The Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End. The Alef to the Tav. It was by it that the universe and all things where framed and created...

...and it is by it, that all will be judged. From it you can run, but you cannot hide, nor ever escape it's truth.

**Awake to righteousness, and sin not; for some have not the knowledge of God: I speak *this* to your shame. - 1 Corinthians 15:34**

And to those have not the knowledge of god, that dismiss the keeping of the Commandments of morality as legalism. Those of this great heresy... I speak this to your shame:

From Barnes Notes:

*Or of the sabbath days.* Gr, "of the sabbaths." The word *Sabbath* in the Old Testament is applied not only to the seventh day, but to all the days of holy rest that were observed by the Hebrews, and particularly to the beginning and close of their great festivals. There is, doubtless, reference to those days in this place, as the word is used in the plural number, and the apostle does not refer particularly to *the* Sabbath properly so called. There is no evidence, from this passage, that he would teach that there was no obligation to observe *any* holy time, for there is not the slightest reason to believe that he meant to teach that one of the ten commandments had ceased to be binding on mankind. If he had used the word in the singular number -- "THE Sabbath"--it would then, of course, have been clear that he meant to teach that that commandment had ceased to be binding, and that a sabbath was no longer to be observed. But the use of the term in the plural number, and the connexion, show that he had his eye on the great number of days which were observed by the Hebrews as festivals, as a part of their ceremonial and typical law--and not to the *moral* law, or the ten commandments. No part of the moral law-- no one of the ten commandments -- could be spoken of as "*a shadow* of good things to come." These commandments are, from the nature of moral law, of perpetual and universal obligation.

From Clarke:

There is no intimation here that the *Sabbath* was done away, or that its moral use was superseded, by the introduction of Christianity. I have shown elsewhere that, *Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy*, is a command of *perpetual obligation*, and can never be superseded but by the final termination of time. As it is a *type* of that

rest which remains for the people of God, of an eternity of bliss, it must continue in full force till that eternity arrives; for no *type* ever ceases till the *antitype* be come.

From JFB:

The weekly sabbath rests on a more permanent foundation, having been instituted in Paradise to commemorate the completion of creation in six days. #Le 23:38| expressly distinguished "the sabbath of the Lord" from the other sabbaths. A *positive* precept is *right because it is commanded*, and ceases to be obligatory when abrogated; a moral precept is *commanded* eternally, *because it is eternally right*. If we could keep a perpetual sabbath, as we shall hereafter, the positive precept of the sabbath, one in each week, would not be needed. #Heb 4:9|, "rests," *Greek*, "keeping of sabbath" (#Isa 66:23|). But we cannot, since even Adam, in innocence, needed one amidst his earthly employments; therefore the sabbath is still needed and is therefore still linked with the other nine commandments, as obligatory in the spirit, though the letter of the law has been superseded by that higher spirit of love which is the essence of law and Gospel alike (#Ro 13:8-10|).
