For this gird you with sackcloth, lament and howl:

for the fierce anger of the LORD is not turned back from us. And it shall come to pass at that day, saith the LORD, *that* the heart of the king shall perish, and the heart of the princes; and the priests shall be astonished, and the prophets shall wonder. Then said I, Ah, Lord GOD! surely thou hast greatly deceived this people and Jerusalem, saying, Ye shall have peace;

whereas the sword reacheth unto the soul. - Jeremiah 4:7-10

Grasp these truths.

Moreover, brethren, I would not that ye should be ignorant, how that all our fathers were under the cloud, and all passed through the sea; And were all baptized unto Moses in the cloud and in the sea; ³And did all eat the same spiritual meat; And did all drink the same spiritual drink: for they drank of that spiritual Rock that followed them: and that Rock was Christ. But with many of them God was not well pleased: for they were overthrown in the wilderness.

From the Clarke Commentary:

Verse 10. *Neither murmur ye]* How the Israelites murmured because of the manna, which their souls despised as a *light bread*-something incapable of affording them nourishment, because they had been brought out of Egypt into the wilderness, and pretended that the promises of God had failed; and how they were destroyed by serpents, and by the destroyer or plague; may be seen at large in the texts referred to in the *margin* on this and the preceding verses. It appears from what the apostle says here, that the Corinthians were murmuring against God and his apostle for prohibiting them from partaking of the idolatrous feasts, just as the Israelites did in the wilderness in reference to a similar subject. See the history of Phineas, with Zimri and Cosbi, and the rebellion of Corah and his company,

Destroyed of the destroyer.] The Jews suppose that God employed *destroying angels* to punish those rebellious Israelites; they were *five* in number, and one of them they call *Meshachith*, the *destroyer*, which appears to be another name for *Samael*, the *angel of death*, to whose influence they attribute all deaths which are not *uncommon* or *violent*. Those who die violent deaths, or deaths that are not in the *common manner* of men, are considered as perishing by immediate judgments from God.

I will shew thee, hear me; and that *which* I have seen I will declare; Which wise men have told from their fathers, and have not hid *it* : Unto whom alone the earth was given, and no stranger passed among them. The wicked man travaileth with pain all *his* days, and the number of years is hidden to the oppressor.

A dreadful sound *is* in his ears: in prosperity the destroyer shall come upon him.

He believeth not that he shall return out of darkness, and he is waited for of the sword. He wandereth abroad for bread, *saying*, Where *is it*? he knoweth that the day of darkness is ready at his hand. - Job 15:17-23

.Trouble and anguish shall make him afraid; they shall prevail against him, as a king ready to the battle. For he stretcheth out his hand against God, and strengtheneth himself against the Almighty. He runneth upon him, *even on his neck*, upon the thick bosses of his bucklers: Because he covereth his face with his fatness, and maketh collops of fat on *his flanks*. And he dwelleth in desolate cities, *and in houses* which no man inhabiteth, which are ready to become heaps. He shall not be rich, neither shall his substance continue, neither shall he prolong the perfection thereof upon the earth. He shall not depart out of darkness; the flame shall dry up his branches, and by the breath of his mouth shall he go away. Let not him that is deceived trust in vanity: for vanity shall be his recompence. It shall be accomplished before his time, and his branch shall not be green. He shall shake off his unripe grape as the vine, and shall cast off his flower as the olive. For the congregation of hypocrites *shall be desolate*, and fire shall consume the tabernacles of bribery. They conceive mischief, and bring forth vanity, and their belly prepareth deceit. - Job 15:24-25

Know this:

A Lukewarm Apostate Church is not His. The Lord do stands at the Door knocking waiting to get in. If you are not His you are Gentile. I speak now of not being grafted in, and of broken off, not of the Gentile Church.

And unto the angel of the church of the Laodiceans write; These things saith the Amen, the faithful and true witness, the beginning of the creation of God; I know thy works, that thou art neither cold nor hot: I would thou wert cold or hot.

So then because thou art lukewarm, and neither cold nor hot, I will spue thee out of my mouth.

Because thou sayest, I am rich, and increased with goods, and have need of nothing; and knowest not that thou art wretched, and miserable, and poor, and blind, and naked: I counsel thee to buy of me gold tried in the fire, that thou mayest be rich; and white raiment, that thou mayest be clothed, and *that* the shame of thy nakedness do not appear; and anoint thine eyes with eyesalve, that thou mayest see. As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten:

be zealous therefore, and repent.

Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear my voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with me.

To him that overcometh

will I grant to sit with me in my throne, even as I also overcame, and am set down with my Father in his throne. He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches. -

Revelation 3:14-21

Now knowing this, reflect upon Jeremiah 4, remember the cycle, and reflect upon what CAN and will be if a fallen church, nation and world, do not return to true doctrine and Jesus Christ. It's not a pretty picture people. In fact that picture is downright SCARY. If you have embraced false doctrine...you are still a GENTILE. A Divided Church is Carnal and Lukewarm. If you are LukeWarm you are still a Gentile. That is why Jesus Christ will vomit you out of His mouth. Vomited , separated from the Lord Jesus Christ. That should make it REALLY REALLY SCARY.

Then know the vast importance of SOUND Doctrine. And not what you perceive it to be. What God and Jesus Christ, and the Apostles perceive and know it to be.

When the fig tree shoots forth you will know that the summer is nigh.

We are grafted into the olive... and the same for the fig.

If you are LukeWarm you are still a Gentile. That is why Jesus Christ will vomit you out of His mouth. Vomited , separated from the Lord Jesus Christ. That should make it REALLY REALLY SCARY.

Makes me shake just thinking about it, and I am almost fearless.

And I say unto you my friends, Be not afraid of them that kill the body, and after that have no more that they can do.

But I will forewarn you whom ye shall fear:

Fear him, which after he hath killed hath power to cast into hell;

yea, I say unto you, Fear him. - The Gospel According to Luke 12:4-5

Fear God. And Jesus Christ was not talking about “reverence”.

Know this my beloved: For it is written; Death is where thy sting? For death is swallowed up in Victory. I say to you then there is no life separate from Christ. No Victory. No life can shoot forth with that light of life, separate from Christ. Jesus Christ... the Messiah. The Son of God, who was and is God.

For whatsoever is born of God overcometh the world: and this is the victory that overcometh the world, *even* our faith. Who is he that overcometh the world, but he that believeth that Jesus is the Son of God?

This is he that came by water and blood, *even* Jesus Christ; not by water only, but by water and blood. And it is the Spirit that beareth witness, because the Spirit is truth. For there are three that bear record in heaven, the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost: and these three are one. And there are three that bear witness in earth, the Spirit, and the water, and the blood: and these three agree in one. If we receive the witness of men, the witness of God is greater: for this is the witness of God which he hath testified of his Son. - 1 john 5:4-9

From Barnes Notes:

Verse 38. *And he that taketh not his cross, etc.* When persons were condemned to be crucified, a part of the sentence was, that they should carry the *cross* on which they were to die to the place of execution. Thus Christ carried his, till he fainted from fatigue and exhaustion. #Mt 27:31|. The cross was usually composed of two rough beams of wood, united in the form of this figure. It was an instrument of death. #Mt 27:31,32|. To carry it was burdensome, was disgraceful, was trying to the feelings, was an addition to the punishment. So, *to carry the cross* is a figurative expression, denoting that we must endure whatever is burdensome, or trying, or considered as disgraceful, in following Christ. It consists simply in doing our duty, let the world think of it or speak of it as they may. It does not consist in making trouble for ourselves, or doing things merely *to be opposed*; it is doing just what is required of us in the

Scriptures, let it produce whatever shame, disgrace, or pain it may. This every follower of Jesus is required to do.

Verse 39. *He that findeth his life*, etc. The word *life* in this passage is used evidently in two senses. The meaning may be expressed thus: He that is anxious to save his *temporal* life, or his comfort and security here, shall lose *eternal* life; or shall fail of heaven. He that is willing to risk, or lose, his comfort and *life* here, for my sake, shall find life everlasting; or shall be saved. The manner of speaking is similar to that where he said, "Let the dead bury their dead."

(For the weapons of our warfare *are* not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;) Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ; . - 2 Corinthians 10:3-5**

I come to bring not peace but a sword.

The Sword of the Spirit...and the "Seven" Stones.

And know this: The Destroyer will come.

"And the Thunder Rolls".

"Feed My Sheep"

Yes my Lord.

Then said one unto him, Lord, are there few that be saved? And he said unto them, **Strive to enter in at the strait gate: for many, I say unto you, will seek to enter in, and shall not be able.**

When once the master of the house is risen up, and hath shut to the door, and ye begin to stand without, and to knock at the door, saying, Lord, Lord, open unto us;

and he shall answer and say unto you, I know you not whence ye are: Then shall ye begin to say, We have eaten and drunk in thy presence, and thou hast taught in our streets. But he shall say, I tell you, I know you not whence ye are; depart from me, all ye workers of iniquity.

There shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth, when ye shall see Abraham, and Isaac, and Jacob, and all the prophets, in the kingdom of God,

and you yourselves thrust out. - The Gospel According to Luke 13:23-28

In this instance Jesus Christ was not talking of Israel but to the Church. The Disciples. And is mirrored in a parallell verse from Matthew:

Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven. Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? and in thy name have cast out devils? and in thy name done many wonderful works? And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity. - Matthew 7:21-23

Who then can be saved? Those that follow Jesus Christ.

For those of you that are dispensationalists. Know that the travail is what you call prior to the tribulation. Grasp this truth.

And there appeared a great wonder in heaven; a woman clothed with the sun, and the moon under her feet, and upon her head a crown of twelve stars: And she being with child cried, travailing in birth, and pained to be delivered.

She is pained to be delivered. She is the Daughter of Zion the Heavenly. The Church.

And there appeared another wonder in heaven; and behold a great red dragon, having seven heads and ten horns, and seven crowns upon his heads. And his tail drew the third part of the stars of heaven, and did cast them to the earth: and the dragon stood before the woman which was ready to be delivered, for to devour her child as soon as it was born.

And she brought forth a man child, who was to rule all nations with a rod of iron: and her child was caught up unto God, and to his throne.

She delivers.

And the woman fled into the wilderness, where she hath a place prepared of God, that they should feed her there a thousand two hundred *and* threescore days.

Three and a half years. After she delivers she flees to the wilderness.

There is war in Heaven. The accuser of the brethren is cast down.

And there was war in heaven: Michael and his angels fought against the dragon; and the dragon fought and his angels, And prevailed not; neither was their place found any more in heaven. And the great dragon was cast out, that old serpent, called the Devil, and Satan, which deceiveth the whole world: he was cast out into the earth, and his angels were cast out with him. And I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, Now is come salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of his Christ: for the accuser of our brethren is cast down, which accused them before our God day and night.

And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death.

Therefore rejoice, ye heavens, and ye that dwell in them.

Woe to the inhabitants of the earth and of the sea! for the devil is come down unto you, having great wrath, because he knoweth that he hath but a short time.

And when the dragon saw that he was cast unto the earth, he persecuted the woman which brought forth the man *child* .

And to the woman were given two wings of a great eagle, that she might fly into the wilderness, into her place, where she is

nourished for a time, and times, and half a time, from the face of the serpent.

Three and a half years.

And the serpent cast out of his mouth water as a flood after the woman, that he might cause her to be carried away of the flood. And the earth helped the woman, and the earth opened her mouth, and swallowed up the flood which the dragon cast out of his mouth.

And the dragon was wroth with the woman, and went to make war with the remnant of her seed, which keep the commandments of God, and have the testimony of Jesus Christ.—Revelation 12

Now know this:

For I would not, brethren, that ye should be ignorant of this mystery, lest ye should be wise in your own conceits; that blindness in part is happened to Israel, until the fulness of the Gentiles be come in. And so all Israel shall be saved: as it is written, There shall come out of Sion the Deliverer, and shall turn away ungodliness from Jacob: For this *is* my covenant unto them, when I shall take away their sins. - Romans 11:25-27

“Remember the Cycle”.

But he that shall endure unto the end, the same shall be saved. And this gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations; and then shall the end come. When ye therefore shall see the abomination of desolation, spoken of by Daniel the prophet, stand in the holy place, (whoso readeth, let him understand:)

that blindness in part is happened to Israel, until the fulness of the Gentiles be come in. And so all Israel shall be saved:

It is the glory of God to conceal a thing:

but the honour of kings *is* to search out a matter.

“Remember the Cycle”.

The heaven for height, and the earth for depth, and the heart of kings *is* unsearchable.

Take away the dross from the silver, and there shall come forth a vessel for the finer. Take away the wicked *from* before the king, and his throne shall be established in righteousness. -
