And perhaps most important may He guide you to that great saving faith, that is not only of the faith of Abraham, but that of the firm "foundation of the prophets and apostles", and of Our Lord Jesus Christ being the chief cornerstone; for:

It is of Faith: That It Might Be By Grace.

Any other foundation, a foundation of the "Doctrines of Mere Men" are sinking sand:

It is of Faith: That It Might Be By Grace.

Therefore it is of faith, that it might be by grace; to the end the promise might be sure to all the seed; not to that only which is of the law, but to that also which is of the faith of Abraham; who is the father of us all, - Romans 4:16

Always hunger and thirst for God, seek His face and you will be filled to overflowing. Hunger, Thirst...such a hunger and thirst I see in your country of Kenya. I pray that I will always see such hunger and thirst there. And one day in all the world... the fire of a thirst and hunger unsatiable... a thirst for righteousness and God, and yes for that "living water" that you may never truly thirst again:

There cometh a woman of Samaria to draw water: Jesus saith unto her, Give me to drink. (For his disciples were gone away unto the city to buy meat.) Then saith the woman of Samaria unto him, How is it that thou, being a Jew, askest drink of me, which am a woman of Samaria? for the Jews have no dealings

with the Samaritans. Jesus answered and said unto her, **If thou knewest the gift of God, and who it is that saith to thee, Give me to drink; thou wouldest have asked of him, and he would have given thee living water.** The woman saith unto him, Sir, thou hast nothing to draw with, and the well is deep: from whence then hast thou that living water? Art thou greater than our father Jacob, which gave us the well, and drank thereof himself, and his children, and his cattle? Jesus answered and said unto her, **Whosoever drinketh of this water shall thirst again: But whosoever drinketh of the water that I shall give him shall never thirst; but the water that I shall give him shall be in him a well of water springing up into everlasting life.** The woman saith unto him, Sir, give me this water, that I thirst not, neither come hither to draw. - The Gospel According to John 4:7-15

Then Jesus said unto them, **Verily, verily, I say unto you, Moses gave you not that bread from heaven; but my Father giveth you the true bread from heaven. For the bread of God is he which cometh down from heaven, and giveth life unto the world.** Then said they unto him, Lord, evermore give us this bread. And Jesus said unto them, **I am the bread of life: he that cometh to me shall never hunger; and he that believeth on me shall never thirst.** - The Gospel According to John 6:32-25

Now as to our Lord Jesus Christ:

But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.

While we where yet sinners; Christ died for us.

Much more then, being now justified by his blood, we shall be saved from wrath through him. For if, when we were enemies, we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, much more, being reconciled, we shall be saved by his life. - Romans 5:8-10

"A Light Unto A World". The light of Christ in us burning brightly, and not as dim.

This then is the message which we have heard of him, and declare unto you, that God is light, and in him is no darkness at all. If we say that we have fellowship with him, and walk in darkness, we lie, and do not the truth: But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin.- 1 John 1:5-7

And hereby we do know that we know him, if we keep his commandments. He that saith, I know him, and keepeth not his commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him. But whoso keepeth his word, in him verily is the love of God perfected: hereby know we that we are in him. He that saith he abideth in him ought himself also so to walk, even as he walked.

Brethren, I write no new commandment unto you, but an old commandment which ye had from the beginning. The old commandment is the word which ye have heard from the beginning. Again, a new commandment I write unto you, which thing is true in him and in you: because the darkness is past, and the true light now shineth. He that saith he is in the light, and hateth his brother, is in darkness even until now. He that

loveth his brother abideth in the light, and there is none occasion of stumbling in him. But he that hateth his brother is in darkness, and walketh in darkness, and knoweth not whither he goeth, because that darkness hath blinded his eyes. - 1 John 2:3-10

The light of Christ in us burning brightly, and not as dim. With love unfeigned for the lost of this generation and of the world:

Love, it should be the very breath that animates are very being... that draws us not only as Christians to one another in fellowship, but that motivates our every "action" of every "waking moment"...love unfeigned... that driving force here again that animates our very being. For if Christ dwells in our hearts by faith, and He in us and we in Him, we are subject to like passions... Anything less is "lukewarm".

Keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life. And of some have compassion, making a difference: And others save with fear, pulling them out of the fire; hating even the garment spotted by the flesh. - Jude 1:21-23

Pulling...Lifting them out of the flames. "The Fallen". Of a World... of a Church.

Lifting them higher... when they are yet unable to stand or reach for themselves. Nor my beloved sister..

able yet to see it.

For if Christ dwells in our hearts by faith, and He in us and we in Him, we are subject to like passions... Anything less is "lukewarm".

But I beseech you , that I may not be bold when I am present with that confidence, wherewith I think to be bold against some, which think of us as if we walked according to the flesh. For

though we walk in the flesh, we do not war after the flesh: (For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;)

Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God,

and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ; And having in a readiness to revenge all disobedience, when your obedience is fulfilled.

Do ye look on things after the outward appearance? If any man trust to himself that he is Christ's, let him of himself think this again, that, as he is Christ's, even so are we Christ's. For though I should boast somewhat more of our authority, which the Lord hath given us for edification, and not for your destruction, I should not be ashamed: - 2 Corinthians 10:2-8

Edification. Building up the Body of Christ. In Love...

For it is of Faith: That it Might Be By Grace.

Now as to your hunger my beloved:

Blessed are ye that hunger now: for ye shall be filled.

Blessed are ye that weep now: for ye shall laugh. - The "Gospel" According to Luke 6:21

Blessed are they which do hunger and thirst after righteousness: for they shall be filled. - The "Gospel" According to Matthew 5:6

Blessed are the pure in heart: for they shall see God.

Blessed are the peacemakers: for they shall be called the children of God. - The "Gospel" According to Matthew 5:8-9

Ye are the salt of the earth:

but if the salt have lost his savour, wherewith shall it be salted? it is thenceforth good for nothing, but to be cast out, and to be trodden under foot of men.

Ye are the light of the world.

A city that is set on an hill cannot be hid. Neither do men light a candle, and put it under a bushel, but on a candlestick; and it giveth light unto all that are in the house. Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven. - The "Gospel" According to Matthew 5:13-16
