This is just rough as of yet but prior to the eruption and earthquake in Indonesia, there was an outbreak of Avian flu and also I believe polio just 11 months earlier.

Prior to the tidal wave that hit Sri Lanka, they had a major bout with Dengue fever, a mosquito-borne viral infection, an endemic in Sri Lanka and many other countries with tropical climates. Dengue can present a wide range of symptoms and can even lead to death. Within the last year in Sri Lanka, (prior to the wave)more than 4,000 people have acquired dengue and at least 22 have died as a result of the infection.

More quick facts that I have searched out:

1906 San Francisco Earthquake. Prior to the Earthquake from 1899-1905 an Epidemic of Bubonic Plague. (Interesting enough a brother told me today) a case of this same thing was just reported in I believe it was Arizona during the last two days).

1945 Alaska Tsunami - Prior to 1945, 50% of all deaths in Alaska, where contributed to Tuberculosis.

1980 Mt St Helens. Eruption. Details are a bit sketchy, as I have pulled this from a Recap history page I located on the net. I have saved the pages to my hard drive if anyone would like them. But within the headlines, there is mention of a 79-80 major flu epidemic in the United States that year. Also 1979 AIDS came to the US.

As to AIDS for one minute let us be brutally honest. If homosexuality (which God finds an abomination), hetero sexual fornication, which is a sin that will keep one from entering the Kingdom of God; that is sexual intercourse outside of the marriage as defined by God between a man and a woman, (not man and man or woman and woman) where both parties are SUPPOSED to be virgin (other wise they have committed fornication), let us be brutally honest for a moment...
