When God comes calling.

Who's Knocking at your door?

Ask ye of the LORD rain in the time of the latter rain; so the LORD shall make bright clouds, and give them showers of rain, to every one grass in the field.

For a voice of wailing is heard out of Zion, How are we spoiled! we are greatly confounded, because we have forsaken the land, because our dwellings have cast *us* out. Yet hear the word of the LORD, O ye women, and let your ear receive the word of his mouth, and teach your daughters wailing, and every one her neighbour lamentation. For death is come up into our windows, *and* is entered into our palaces, to cut off the children from without, *and* the young men from the streets.

Speak, Thus saith the LORD, Even the carcasses of men shall fall as dung upon the open field, and as the handful after the harvestman, and none shall gather *them* .

Thus saith the LORD, Let not the wise *man* glory in his wisdom, neither let the mighty *man* glory in his might, let not the rich *man* glory in his riches: But let him that glorieth glory in this, that he understandeth and knoweth me, that I *am* the LORD which exercise lovingkindness, judgment, and righteousness, in the earth: for in these *things* I delight, saith the LORD. - Jeremiah 9:10-24

Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that I will punish all *them which are* circumcised with the uncircumcised; Egypt, and Judah, and Edom, and the children of Ammon, and Moab, and all *that are* in the utmost corners, that dwell in the wilderness: for all *these nations are* uncircumcised, and all the house of Israel *are* uncircumcised in the heart. - Jeremiah 9:25-26

In the meantime note the cloud in the west, do be designated different from the normal as in most things in scripture I have found talking of east to the west. Perhaps all the good promises of God that I have found such as the removal of sin through Christ, and Christ's arrival is from the east to the west. Yet perhaps God's the Father's judgment or a shower or rain comes west to east, I don't know, as I said there is something here prophetically... I just have to uncover it's truth. Our Lord was specific when He used the term shower or rain, and also using the example of heat. He used those two. Here again I have to uncover it's truth, and it's relationship to all the things He has been teaching me. I have that feeling deep in my spirit, that this is something vastly more than He reminding them just of the normal pattern of cloud movement. It wouldn't have much to do with the signs of the times.)

For if we sin wilfully after that we have received the knowledge of the truth, there remaineth no more sacrifice for sins, But a certain fearful looking for of judgment and fiery indignation, which shall devour the adversaries. He that despised Moses' law died without mercy under two or three witnesses: Of how much sorer punishment, suppose ye, shall he be thought worthy, who hath trodden under foot the Son of God, and hath counted the blood of the covenant, wherewith he was sanctified, an unholy thing, and hath done despite unto the Spirit of grace?

For we know him that hath said, Vengeance *belongeth* unto me, I will recompense, saith the Lord. And again, The Lord shall judge his people. *It is* a fearful thing to fall into the hands of the living God. - Hebrews 10:26-31

Awake to righteousness, and sin not; for some have not the knowledge of God: I speak *this* to your shame. - 1 Corinthians 15:34
