“I AM The Lord Thy God. You Are Yet Wild, and Not Yet Tame”.

Now let us begin. Well before we begin I should say, there is something we have covered briefly before, a “Great Mystery of the Kingdom of God and of Heaven”. That God once again this very morning, wishes me to cover once again:

And Jesus answered and spake unto them again by parables, and said, The kingdom of heaven is like unto a certain king, which made a marriage for his son, And sent forth his servants to call them that were bidden to the wedding: and they would not come. - The Gospel According to Matthew 22:1-3

In the beginning of this parable, the servants are the prophets, and those bidden is the people of Israel.

Again, he sent forth other servants, saying, Tell them which are bidden, Behold, I have prepared my dinner: my oxen and my fatlings are killed, and all things are ready: come unto the marriage. But they made light of it, and went their ways, one to his farm, another to his merchandise: And the remnant took his servants, and entreated them spitefully, and slew them . - The Gospel According to Matthew 22:4-5

Now verses 4 and 5 are when Jesus Christ the Lord, came and bid those to the wedding. This is too when He did His atoning work on the Cross. This also a "picture" of the "remnant" spoken of by Paul, and the severe persecution of the early church. Yes, the stoning of Stephen and the persecution by Saul. **One of the "keys" to understanding this parable is "the Remnant"**. For even in the Old Testament, Joel spoke of the "great and terrible day of the Lord", and the "remnant that God would call. "The Great and terrible day of the Lord", that occurred after the Crucifixion of Christ, when after the daughters prophesied, ...what Peter spoke of...etc...

(Remember too this all a cycle. I am trying to not to confuse you, but understand, sometimes it is difficult for me to not get off subject in scripture, for all of scripture, "the deeper levels, and the deepest level "The Logos" are a finely interwoven mesh or layer that goes through out the entire scripture, both "Old and New Testaments". Actually it is here where I spend all my time, so it is hard for me to not flow to other parts of scripture, for all is related one to another. Do you have understanding for this? A highly woven fabric. That too is the Word made flesh. Perhaps for most of you, you cannot even to begin to sound out or fathom the depths I am speaking of.)

One of the "keys" to understanding this parable is "the Remnant".

And it is for this purpose Paul, who was Saul, spoke of in his epistle to the Romans:

And that he might make known the riches of his glory on the vessels of mercy, which he had afore prepared unto glory, Even us, whom he hath called, not of the Jews only, but also of the Gentiles?

As he saith also in Osee, I will call them my people, which were not my people; and her beloved, which was not beloved. And it shall come to pass, *that* in the place where it was said unto them, Ye *are* not my people; there shall they be called the children of the living God. Esaias also crieth concerning Israel, Though the number of the children of Israel be as the sand of the sea, a remnant shall be saved: - Romans 9:23-28

I say then, Hath God cast away his people? God forbid. For I also am an Israelite, of the seed of Abraham, of the tribe of Benjamin. God hath not cast away his people which he foreknew. Wot ye not what the scripture saith of Elias? how he maketh intercession to God against Israel, saying, Lord, they have killed thy prophets, and digged down thine altars; and I am left alone, and they seek my life. But what saith the answer of God unto him? I have reserved to myself seven thousand men, who have not bowed the knee to *the image of Baal*.

Even so then at this present time also there is a remnant according to the election of grace. And if by grace, then *is it* no more of works: otherwise grace is no more grace. But if *it be* of works, then is it no more grace: otherwise work is no more work. What then? Israel hath not obtained that which he seeketh for; but the election hath obtained it, and the rest were blinded (According as it is written, God hath given them the spirit of slumber, eyes that they should not see, and ears that they should not hear;) unto this day. And David saith, Let their table be made a snare, and a trap, and a stumblingblock, and a recompence unto them: Let their eyes be darkened, that they may not see, and bow down their back alway. I say then, Have they stumbled that they should fall? God forbid: but *rather* through their fall salvation *is come* unto the Gentiles, for to provoke them to jealousy. Now if the fall of them *be* the riches of the world, and the diminishing of them the riches of the Gentiles; how much more their fulness? For I speak to you

Gentiles, inasmuch as I am the apostle of the Gentiles, I magnify mine office: - Romans 11:1-13

Here again in the above verses Paul is not only talking about what was leading into the “Gentile Graft”, he was talking about the blindness of Israel and the “remnant”, that was preserved.

Remember the Gentile Graft. As we will be getting back to that in a moment. (Always remember the Graft. The Baptists and Catholics ignore this truth, and the truth that you can be grafted in, you can too be broken off. The lie of “Once Saved Always Saved”, that so many of you succumb too, and pervert the Gospel and the true “Perseverance of the Saints”. And I am talking about Calvin’s twisted version of it. But that is yet another teaching. You know I had an encounter with hyper Calvinism, a few weeks ago, I think I wrote about it. The person told me that “God will persevere for you. Live how you want, have an evil heart all you want; That’s a lie straight from a Devil’s Hell. He told me once, He knew what evil was in his heart. Apparently he missed the “reins” and the below scripture from James:

Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. Draw nigh to God, and he will draw nigh to you. Cleanse your hands, ye sinners; and purify your hearts, ye double minded. Be afflicted, and mourn, and weep: let your laughter be turned to mourning, and your joy to heaviness. Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and he shall lift you up. - James 4:7-10

This man is in for an extremely sore and painful travail. If it doesn’t end up destroying him. To know what evil is in your heart, and do nothing about it? Speak about the deception of Satan... but this is how many of you think. That God will persevere for you. “Once Saved Always Saved”. “Security of the Believer, believe what you only wish to believe and discard the rest.

Cleanse your hands, ye sinners; and purify your hearts, ye double minded.

Now God wishes me at this time to address more of this “Calvinism” lie, and confront it head on, so being his servant, here goes.... The following is an excerpt from “Christianity Today” on Calvinism, that recently ended up in my mailbox (Gee wiz imagine that):

Irresistible grace: Those God elects cannot resist the Holy Spirit's draw to salvation (John 6:44; 1 Cor. 1:23-24; Acts 16:14). Again, **this contrasts** with Christian traditions that teach that we are able to reject God's forgiveness—thus, while God may choose to save everyone, not everyone chooses to believe.

Perseverance of the saints: By God's power, believers will endure in faith to the end (John 10:28; Rom. 8:30; Phil. 1:6). Other Christian traditions teach that people can **forsake faith** and lose salvation.

Now at this time God, so wishes me to provide you with a bit of scripture, to “shed light” upon those to heretical doctrines, that I have mentioned above. Remember this too only briefly covers or scratches the surface, on Calvin's perverted Gospel, such also is total depravity of man, etc... if fact it was Calvin that started all this “Once Saved Always Saved”, and your twisted version of the “Perseverance of the Saints”...now to the scripture God wishes me to provide you:

Therefore **it is of faith, that it might be by grace; to the end the promise might be sure to all the seed; not to that only which is of the law, but to that also which is of the faith of Abraham; who is the father of us all,** - Romans 4:16

This is not “Irresistible Grace”. Neither is this:

Be not highminded, but fear: For if God spared not the natural branches, take heed lest he also spare not thee. goodness, if thou continue in *his* goodness: otherwise thou also shalt be cut off. - Romans 11:19-22

But it has a “whole” lot to do with FAITH. “The Faith”.

This is not “Irresistible Grace”. Neither is this:

“Irresistible grace: Those God elects cannot resist the Holy Spirit's draw to salvation”

Quench not the Spirit - 1 Thessalonians 5:19

Oh Oh... guess a whole bunch of you missed that one and this one:

Ye stiffnecked and uncircumcised in heart and ears, ye do always resist the Holy Ghost: as your fathers *did* , so *do ye*. - Acts 7:51

Ye have not yet resisted unto blood, striving against sin. - Hebrews 12:4

Now understand as to this above verse, not resisting unto blood, striving against sin, is not salvation.... Is not salvation...but it is it is ends with A VERY EXTREMELY SORE TRAVAIL:

Now as to the above verse, yes I know that people do sin, and yes God as the loving Father is forgiving. The Lord knows I have made my share of mistakes. But what we are talking about here, is not a trip, but a continuous lifetime for most of you, walking in sin and false doctrine. As I also understand that people do sin, inadvertently. Not meaning to.

Now let me toss to you yet one more “nugget” of truth, if you will, that I had to discover the hard way. Satan, my arch enemy is very very good at what he does. He’s really pretty slick. Not giving him any credit now. Don’t take me wrong. But he is good at what he does. He is far older than you or I. Don’t underestimate him. I don’t. All though there was a time I did. And it has cost me.

But know this, he is good at what he does. It wasn’t until even after a few mistakes made after the trailer in Newark, even that I came to realize this. Just as it wasn’t until God gave me my “special gift of vision”, I came to the realization, that Satan’s plans to thwart your life, often encompass months and years... by this I mean, he is so slick he will start his plan to thwart you sometimes years in advance... placing a piece here and a piece there... most people think his attack on you is immediate... and sometimes it is. But it is the “unseen” pieces, over the months, and the years... that will get you.

Don’t underestimate him.

Now God so wishes me to take the above verse yet one step further, to show you the travail.....

For whom the Lord loveth he chasteneth, and scourgeth every son whom he receiveth. If ye endure chastening, God dealeth with you as with sons; for what son is he whom the father chasteneth not? But if ye be without chastisement, whereof all are partakers, then are ye bastards, and not sons. Furthermore we have had fathers of our flesh which corrected *us* , and we gave *them* reverence: shall we not much rather be in subjection unto the Father of spirits, and live? For they verily for a few days chastened *us* after their own pleasure; but he for *our* profit, that *we* might be partakers of his holiness. Now no chastening for the present seemeth to be joyous, but grievous: nevertheless

afterward it yieldeth the peaceable fruit of righteousness unto them which are exercised thereby. Wherefore lift up the hands which hang down, and the feeble knees;

And make straight paths for your feet, lest that which is lame be turned out of the way;

[Nothing worse then a lame “wild horse”]

but let it rather be healed. Follow peace with all *men* , and holiness, without which no man shall see the Lord: Looking diligently lest any man fail of the grace of God; lest any root of bitterness springing up trouble *you* , and thereby many be defiled; Lest there *be* any fornicator, or profane person, as Esau, who for one morsel of meat sold his birthright. For ye know how that afterward, when he would have inherited the blessing, he was rejected: for he found no place of repentance, though he sought it carefully with tears.

For ye are not come unto the mount that might be touched, and that burned with fire, nor unto blackness, and darkness, and tempest, And the sound of a trumpet, and the voice of words; which *voice* they that heard intreated that the word should not be spoken to them any more: (For they could not endure that which was commanded, And if so much as a beast touch the mountain, it shall be stoned, or thrust through with a dart: And so terrible was the sight, *that* Moses said, I exceedingly fear and quake:) But ye are come unto mount Sion, and unto the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem, and to an innumerable company of angels, To the general assembly and church of the firstborn, which are written in heaven, and to God the Judge of all, and to the spirits of just men made perfect, And to Jesus the mediator of the new covenant, and to the blood of sprinkling, that speaketh better things than *that of* Abel. See that ye refuse not him that speaketh. For if they escaped not who refused him that spake on earth, much more *shall not we escape* , if we turn away from him that *speaketh* from heaven: Whose voice then shook the earth: but now he hath promised, saying, Yet once more I shake not the earth only, but also heaven. And this *word* , Yet once more, signifieth the removing of those things that are shaken, as of things that are made, that those things which

cannot be shaken may remain. Wherefore we receiving a kingdom which cannot be moved, let us have grace, whereby we may serve God acceptably with reverence and godly fear:

For our God *is* a consuming fire. - Hebrews 12:6-28

You better believe it. That fire will “Consume you”... take it to heart, “Wild Horses”.

Let every soul be subject unto the higher powers. For there is no power but of God: the powers that be are ordained of God. Whosoever therefore resisteth the power, resisteth the ordinance of God: and they that resist shall receive to themselves damnation. - Romans 13:1-2

You can resist the “powers” which too is the true minister of God, as you can quench and resist the Spirit: Oh Oh... guess you missed that one “Once Saved Always Saved”...

“Irresistible grace: Those God elects cannot resist the Holy Spirit's draw to salvation”

You have no idea, how bad I loathe and hate the false paths Calvin created. That damn men’s souls. No to some of you “loath” may appear to be quite a strong word, but after all scripture tells us to hate all evil.

And before you send me any email’s on this, I too like David hate ever false way. I am allowed that:

Through thy precepts I get understanding: therefore I hate every false way. - Psalms 119:104

Now understand why I dislike or hate the doctrines of Calvin so greatly. Just as the man (who knew his evil heart and did nothing about it), who was provided as an example for you, those that embrace these doctrines, are lulled into a false sense of security, and lose sight of the fact the key role that faith plays. That’s what these doctrines have created, a complacent church, “lulled into sleep”. Understand this form of Calvinism that we just covered, exists in

many forms, a complacent “Once Saved Always Saved church, doesn’t have to do anything, they don’t even have to follow Christ.

Now as to the perseverance of the saints, :

Perseverance of the saints: By God's power, believers will endure in faith to the end (John 10:28; Rom. 8:30; Phil. 1:6). Other Christian traditions teach that people can **forsake faith** and lose salvation.

You must take the above doctrine of Calvin in light and not in darkness. Remember Calvin teaches you are elected to salvation, a teaching that then makes the need for true faith void...and the Bible does not teach that.

Brethren, if any of you do err from the truth, and one convert him; Let him know, that he which converteth the sinner from the error of his way shall save a soul from death, and shall hide a multitude of sins. - James 5:19-20

It is of Faith, that it might be by Grace.

To him that overcomes, that endures to the end, that keeps God’s word, this is the true perseverance of the saints.

He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; To him that overcometh will I give to eat of the tree of life, which is in the midst of the paradise of God. - Revelation 2:7

But he that shall endure unto the end, the same shall be saved. - The Gospel According to Matthew 24:13

And he that overcometh, and keepeth my works unto the end, to him will I give power over the nations: And he shall rule them with a rod of iron; as the vessels of a potter shall they be broken to shivers: even as I received of my Father. And I will give him the morning star. - Revelation 2:26-28

And she brought forth a man child, who was to rule all nations with a rod of iron: and her child was caught up unto God, and to his throne - Revelation 12:5

Who then is a faithful and wise servant, whom his lord hath made ruler over his household, to give them meat in due season? Blessed is that servant, whom his lord when he cometh shall find so doing. Verily I say unto you, That he shall make him ruler over all his goods. - The Gospel According to Matthew 24:45-47

Who is it then is that faithful servant giving them meat in due season?

The first was like a lion, and had eagle's wings: I beheld till the wings thereof were plucked, and it was lifted up from the earth, and made stand upon the feet as a man, and a man's heart was given to it. - Daniel 7:4

Revelation 2:4-6

Overcoming is not “automatic” as Calvin teaches. Nor is the above verse a reflection of the heretical teaching, “Irresistible Grace”. You have to do something...

“You Have to Follow Jesus Christ”. And you people have left your first love.

Calvin has really messed you Baptists up. But let me add, before the Catholics get on their high “pale” horse, they have their own version and as God is so prompting me now to write, “deviant” from the truth that has messed themselves up too. “Deviant”. For nation shall rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom: and there shall be famines, and pestilences, and earthquakes, in divers places. All these are the beginning of sorrows. - The Gospel According to Matthew 24:7-8

And just briefly the Abbott Commentary:

There was a literal fulfilment of these predictions just before the destruction of Jerusalem.

This the travail of the early church. And an image of your travail as well. "It's All A Cycle".

And a "picture" if you will, of the final cycle a part of the fulfillment of all things yet unfulfilled, and restoration of all things. For all these things occur, and more, that proceed the return of Jesus Christ. AND THE DESTRUCTION OF JERUSALEM ONCE MORE.

Thus saith the Lord GOD; It shall also come to pass, *that* at the same time shall things come into thy mind, and thou shalt think an evil thought: And thou shalt say, I will go up to the land of unwalled villages; I will go to them that are at rest, that dwell safely, all of them dwelling without walls, and having neither bars nor gates, To take a spoil, and to take a prey; to turn thine hand upon the desolate places *that are now* inhabited, and upon the people *that are* gathered out of the nations, which have gotten cattle and goods, that dwell in the midst of the land. Sheba, and Dedan, and the merchants of Tarshish, with all the young lions thereof, shall say unto thee, Art thou come to take a spoil? hast thou gathered thy

company to take a prey? to carry away silver and gold, to take away cattle and goods, to take a great spoil?

Therefore, son of man, prophesy and say unto Gog, Thus saith the Lord GOD; In that day when my people of Israel dwelleth safely, shalt thou not know *it*? And thou shalt come from thy place out of the north parts, thou, and many people with thee, all of them riding upon horses, a great company, and a mighty army:

And thou shalt come up against my people of Israel, as a cloud to cover the land; it shall be in the latter days, and I will bring thee against my land, that the heathen may know me, when I shall be sanctified in thee, O Gog, before their eyes. Thus saith the Lord GOD; *Art* thou he of whom I have spoken in old time by my servants the prophets of Israel, which prophesied in those days *many* years that I would bring thee against them?
