Mine anger was kindled against the shepherds, and I punished the goats: for the LORD of hosts hath visited his flock the house of Judah, and hath made them as his goodly horse in the battle. Out of him came forth the corner, out of him the nail, out of him the battle bow, out of him every oppressor together.**

**And they shall be as mighty *men* , which tread down *their enemies* in the mire of the streets in the battle: and they shall fight, because the LORD *is* with them, and the riders on horses shall be confounded. And I will strengthen the house of Judah, and I will save the house of Joseph, and I will bring them again to place them; for I have mercy upon them: and they shall be as though I had not cast them off: for I *am* the LORD their God, and will hear them. - Zechariah 10:1-6**

Now at this point, don't go jumping on the highminded proud Catholic and Baptist bandwagon and start beating your drums. This speaks of Israel and the Church as a whole. As a whole. Know and grasp this very very quickly dear heart:

**Therefore it is of faith, that it might be by grace; to the end the promise might be sure to all the seed; not to that only which is of the law, but to that also which is of the faith of Abraham; who is the father of us all, - Romans 4:16**

The vast importance the role faith is going to play, in Mercy...and in Grace.

**Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen. For by it the elders obtained a good report. Through faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that things which are seen were not made of things which do appear. By faith Abel offered unto God a more excellent sacrifice than Cain, by which he obtained witness that he was righteous, God testifying of his gifts: and by it he being dead yet speaketh. By faith Enoch was translated that he should not see death; and was not found, because God had translated him: for before his translation he had this testimony, that he pleased God.**

**But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and *that* he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him. By faith Noah, being warned of God of things not seen as yet, moved with fear, prepared an ark**

to the saving of his house; by the which he condemned the world, and became heir of the righteousness which is by faith. - Hebrews 11:1-7

A man hath joy by the answer of his mouth: and a word *spoken* in due season, how good *is it*! The way of life *is* above to the wise, that he may depart from hell beneath - Proverbs 15:23-24

Now know that to a fallen church that has embrace their own 280 versions of the faith, which are the denominations, along with enough false doctrine muck, that miry clay that sucks the very life from you, is all true truth that has been forsaken. And yes tolerance and complacency, plays a vast role as well. This is why they call it “falling away”.

A modern church that has so emphasized Grace, that I have forgotten somewhere along the road, that it is of faith that it might be by grace. Now understand what I am going to say, and do not take it out of the context that I am giving it, as you do most of the scriptures.

Those in the church today, well such as the highminded vain Baptists and the Catholics and a few others, have so taken grace, God’s grace and mercy to a point they have lost sight of truth. They have lost vision and sight as most of the church has, that it is “important as to what one believes”, and not all paths are the same. Remember the strait gate.

And this is all seen in the doctrines of men, “Once Saved Always Saved”, and “Security of the Believer”. As I have told you before, there is “Security in Christ”, but only as long as you abide on the vine. And this is reflected upon once again by Paul in the Book of Romans Chapter 11:

**Thou wilt say then, The branches were broken off, that I might be grafted in. Well; because of unbelief they were broken off, and thou standest by faith. Be not highminded, but fear: For if God spared not the natural branches, take heed lest he also spare not thee. Behold therefore the goodness and severity of God: on them which fell, severity; but toward thee, goodness, if thou continue in *his* goodness: otherwise thou also shalt be cut off. - Romans 11:19-22**

***“Wherefore he saith, God resisteth the proud, but giveth grace unto the humble. Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. And as we move forward, we are actually moving backwards. I spoke of this all in “The Refreshing Series” located in our ministry archives. Part 5 of that series contains charts as well.

Now understand this. And this something I have spoken of before in the pages and files of Phoenix Seven. And it comes from me.

When God first started to teach me some 17 months ago, one of the first things He started speaking me to about is the latter rain, the cycle, and the lightning. *Would you... "Sing"?*

**Rejoice evermore. Pray without ceasing. In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you.** - 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18

In Days of Adversity - He Gives Us Grace.

And to whom Grace is Already Given. He gives yet more Grace.

“It Sings”

**To the chief Musician, A Song or Psalm. Make a joyful noise unto God, all ye lands: Sing forth the honour of his name: make his praise glorious. Say unto God, How terrible *art thou in thy works!* through the greatness of thy power shall thine enemies submit themselves unto thee. All the earth shall worship thee, and shall sing unto thee; they shall sing to thy name. Selah.**

Come and see the works of God: *he is terrible in his doing* toward the children of men. He turned the sea into dry *land* : they went through the flood on foot: there did we rejoice in him. And as for ALL the rest? You have left your first love, by following a false Word, you are fully "leavened"...repeat your first works. You can't err from the truth and still be saved:
