For I say unto you, Ye shall not see me henceforth, till ye shall say, Blessed is he that cometh in the name of the Lord - The Gospel According to Matthew 23:37-39**

This is true understanding.. This is true wisdom. I am not a "Theologian" by your "Standards"... "I am God Taught"... Oh you dead dry bones! There is "No Life", no freedom from wrath, separate from Jesus Christ! Only "Desolation".

Stop hanging onto “Jewish Fables”, and “Doctrines of Mere Men”. Be full grown men and women! Be “Christian’s”.

Now Read On.
