*Red, White, and Blue and the true Unity in Christ.*

*Red— The Sardine - The Precious Blood of Christ.*

*White - The Diamond—Son of My Right Hand*

*Blue - The Sapphire - Faith and the Throne of God -*

*(Ezekiel 1, 2 Corinthians 6:16, Ephesians 3:17)*

*“It’s A Matter of Heart”.*

Now just briefly, as to the abandoned by Ethiopia, God would now have me address this, and how they have now opted for a flag with the “Star of David”:

**and shall assemble the outcasts of Israel;** so those of his people among the ten tribes, that were scattered about in various countries,

when the Gospel was preached throughout the world by the apostles, were called by it, and gathered into Gospel churches among the Gentiles, of whom the first churches of Christ consisted; and so it will be in the latter day, when all Israel shall be saved:

<sup>JESSE</sup>firm, or a gift, a son of Obed, the son of Boaz and Ruth (Ruth 4:17, 22; Matt. 1:5, 6; Luke 3:32). He was the father of eight sons, the youngest of whom was David (1 Sam. 17:12). The phrase "stem of

Jesse" is used for the family of David (Isa. 11:1), and "root of Jesse" for the Messiah (Isa. 11:10; Rev. 5:5). Jesse was a man apparently of wealth and position at Bethlehem (1 Sam. 17:17, 18, 20; Ps. 78:71). The last reference to him is of David's procuring for him an asylum with the king of Moab (1 Sam. 22:3).

He that despised Moses' law died without mercy under two or three witnesses: Of how much sorer punishment, suppose ye, shall he be thought worthy, who hath trodden under foot the Son of God, and hath counted the blood of the covenant, wherewith he was sanctified, an unholy thing, and hath done despite unto the Spirit of grace?**

**For we know him that hath said, Vengeance *belongeth* unto me, I will recompense, saith the Lord. And again, The Lord shall judge his people. *It is a fearful thing to fall into the hands of the living God.*** - Hebrews 10:25-30
