Now as to all of this, honestly this is not at all what I thought God would have me write to you this morning. But then again it seldom ever is.

What I thought we would be addressing is either more doctrine as in the first three parts of this message. Or as He has been covering with me, “The Four Faces” of me that He has had me address to you before, and of the Last face seen, the “Face of Dan”, the Face of the Eagle. And how Dan is not present of those of the 144 Thousand that are sealed in the last half of the Great Tribulation, and as mentioned of those sealed, in the Book of Revelation.

A “Great Mystery “The Face of Dan”.

Yet scripture states that “ALL of Israel shall be saved”.

And Dan is once again seen here in the scripture from Ezekiel:

Now these *are* the names of the tribes. From the north end to the coast of the way of Hethlon, as one goeth to Hamath, Hazarenan, the border of Damascus northward, to the coast of Hamath; for these are his sides east *and* west; a portion for Dan. - Ezekiel 48:1

And to the woman were given two wings of a great eagle, that she might fly into the wilderness, into her place, where she is nourished for a time, and times, and half a time, from the face of the serpent. - Revelation 12:14

But now as to Judha, God would not have you ignorant, and this next scripture He is guiding me to:

If therefore perfection were by the Levitical priesthood, (for under it the people received the law,) what further need was *there* that another priest should rise after the order of Melchisedec, and not be called after the order of Aaron?

For the priesthood being changed, there is made of necessity a change also of the law.

For he of whom these things are spoken pertaineth to another tribe, of which no man gave attendance at the altar. For *it is* evident that our Lord sprang out of Juda; of which tribe Moses spake nothing concerning priesthood.

And it is yet far more evident: for that after the similitude of Melchisedec there ariseth another priest, Who is made, not after the law of a carnal commandment, but after the power of an endless life. For he testifieth, Thou *art* a priest for ever after the order of Melchisedec. - Hebrews 7:11-16

So also Christ glorified not himself to be made an high priest; but he that said unto him, Thou art my Son, to day have I begotten thee. As he saith also in another *place* , Thou *art* a priest for ever after the order of Melchisedec.

Who in the days of his flesh, when he had offered up prayers and supplications with strong crying and tears unto him that

was able to save him from death, and was heard in that he feared;

Though he were a Son, yet learned he obedience by the things which he suffered; And being made perfect, he became the author of eternal salvation unto all them that obey him;
